The Grey Sauble Conservation Foundation awards an annual \$1000 scholarship to a graduating secondary school student entering a post-secondary program in an environmental or resource management related field. In 2013, the scholarship award was renamed to honour Malcolm Kirk, who passed away in 2012. Mr. Kirk was instrumental in acquiring almost 80% of the landholdings that Grey Sauble Conservation Authority manages today.

The Grey Sauble Conservation Foundation is proud to announce that this year's recipient of the Malcolm Kirk Environmental Scholarship is Erik Van Den Kieboom, a student from Owen Sound District Secondary School. Erik is pursuing his post-secondary education in Environmental Sciences at the University of Guelph where he will be majoring in natural resources and conservation biology.
