Job Description

Reporting to the Forestry Coordinator, the role of the Tree Planter is to assist with the planting of trees on private land and on Grey Sauble Conservation Authority (GSCA) lands and perform other forestry related activities.

This position will include, but is not limited to:

- Assist GSCA forestry staff with tree planting operations;
- Manual and/or mechanical tree planting, loading and unloading of nursery stock, potting trees and shrubs; and
- Other duties related to GSCA operations as assigned.

Skills and Experience:

- Secondary school graduation and/or related job experience.
- Valid Ontario class G driver's license with clean driving abstract.
- Knowledge of tree species and planting practices is considered an asset.
- Ability to demonstrate safe operation of vehicles, equipment, and tools.
- Able to work in a team environment.
- Reliable, honest, hardworking, and motivated self-starter.
- Ability to work long hours outdoors, including weekend work as required.
- Heavy lifting required (up to 25 kg).
